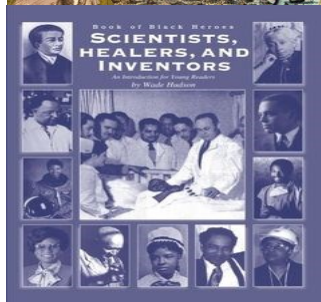
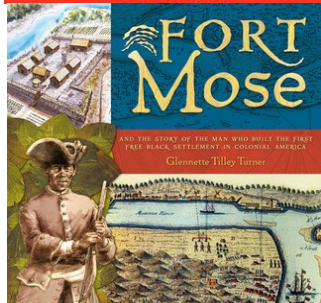
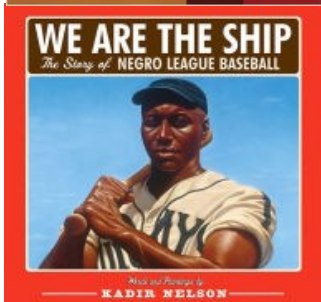
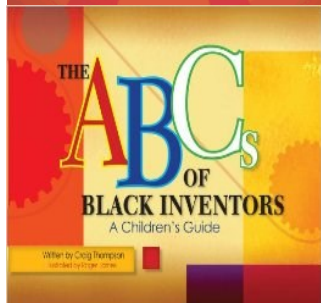
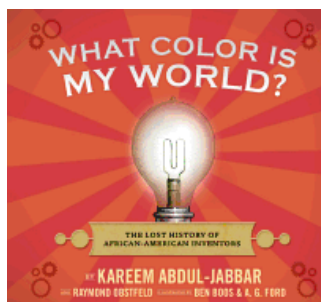


2016 Afriware Summer Reading Challenge
